OIL

ABSTRACT

MIXED MEDIA (2-D, for example, w/c & ink)

PASTELS

COLLAGE (2-D OR 3-D, consists of items combined by glue or such to create finished work)

CLAY

METAL

JEWELRY (finished, wearable work)

COMPUTER ART - (definition, drawing or painting on the computer, resources provided by the artist)

BLACK & WHITE PHOTOGRAPHY

COLOR PHOTOGRAPHY

PHOTOGRAPHY - OTHER (hand tinted, extreme enhancement or printing technique)

Grouped Categories

DRAWING

To include but not limited to: Charcoal, Graphite, Pen & Ink, Conte Crayon, Colored Pencil

GLASS

To include but not limited to: Blown, Fused, Stained, Slumped, but not wearable jewelry

PRINTMAKING

To include but not limited to: Mono Print, Woodcut, Block, Screen

DECORATED ART

To include but not limited to: Decoupage, Mosaic, Paper, Papier Mache, Painted Glass, Soft Sculpture

ASSEMBLAGE

To include but not limited to: recycled art, driftwood sculpture, found art

TEXTILES

To include but not limited to: weaving, art quilts

WOOD - Sculpture/Carved, Functional

AWARDS

1st, 2nd & 3rd place ribbons may be awarded in all divisions by a panel of no more than three (3) judges. There will be a Judge's Award for "Best in Show" and a People's Choice Award. On occasion, an Honorable Mention ribbon may be awarded
