

ART AROUND TOWN GUIDELINES

Program Description

This program features PAA artists' work in on-going exhibitions at the Ocean Beach Hospital & Ilwaco Library.

Each show lasts two months and the artwork displayed may be sold or marked NFS, as the artist wishes.

Artists are responsible to hang their work in a timely manner at the designated locations of each site and to remove them when the two month period is complete.

You will receive a reminder call about the "hang" and "remove" dates from Veronica Frink.

If a piece sells, the artist may replace it with another for the duration of the exhibition.

All sales are conducted directly between the artist and the collector. There is no charge to participate and no commission on sales.

Artists may exhibit one or more paintings.

Instructions to Artists

- At this time, the Ilwaco Hospital will not accept abstract work, nudity or themes that can be interpreted as dark or depressing. They are looking for uplifting work with a positive attitude.
- Work must be accompanied with a business sized card that includes: the artist's name, phone number, the name of the piece (medium is optional but nice to include), and the price of the piece or a marking of NFS (not for sale). You may include other info on the card such as an email address or website address but are asked to not include flyers, info sheets, coupons or other such marketing material on the art or surrounding wall.
- The card is to be affixed to the front of the painting, tucking it into the frame can work very well.
- Nails and hooks are already in place, please use these, do not add hangers of any type.
- Artists handle all inquiries about possible sales and conduct any sales transactions.
- Art should be *art show* ready - sparkling clean, well matted & framed and wired for hanging.
- Artist is responsible to hang and take down their art on the dates given to them by the coordinator.
