



Guidelines for the Jazz & Oysters 2020 Poster Contest

- Contest is open to the public, amateur and professional artists may apply
- All submissions must be 2-D
- Submitted art must not exceed 11 x 17 inches
- All art media are accepted, including photography
- Work must be original
- Finished poster will be 11 x 18 inches
- Poster will be in a limited edition, signed printing of 50
- Submitted art must be unframed (and protected in a sleeve, folder, etc.)
- Art may be signed
- Festival text will be added later. Please do not include festival text in your submission
- Entry form must accompany EACH submission, attached in a safe and secure manner
- Artist may submit up to two (2) pieces

The Jazz & Oysters event takes place at the Port of Peninsula in Nahcotta, WA, which serves the oyster industry. Jazz bands will play on the stage barge located within the park overlooking Willapa Bay. The winning artwork will best illustrate the spirit and essence of the Jazz & Oyster festival, and may be inspired by the event location. Bold, clear design with excellent use of color is optimal.

Submissions are to be dropped off Tuesday, June 16, 2020 between 5 – 6pm at the Public Utilities District 2 – Conference Room, 9610 Sandridge Road, Long Beach, WA 98631.

Peninsula Arts Association members and representatives from the Jazz & Oyster event who are present at the June 16th meeting will vote for the winning poster. The winner will be notified by June 17th.

Winning artist receives a \$75 cash prize and a gift of two (2) posters

All winning image reproduction rights and original artwork become the property of Peninsula Arts Association. No further compensation, other than the Cash Prize and Poster Allocation, will be awarded. Winning artist will be acknowledged whenever the artwork is used and may reference the work in their portfolio and as a marketing tool, but may not sell further images of the piece. Artist agrees to be available to sign all 50 limited edition prints, at a mutually agreed upon time, before the unveiling date of August 1st

All non-chosen poster entries must be picked up between 10-4pm, August 5th-8th, at M & D Designs in downtown Long Beach at 302 Highway #103, Long Beach, WA 98631.
